DESCRIPTION

Adobe Illustrator software is the design industry's premier vector-drawing program. Through this class you will learn the skills and methods of design using Adobe Illustrator. All projects will be completed through the design process from research to sketches to a final solution. Through this process a clear understanding of the design principles will be gained. You will also gain a strong perspective to see the world around you in a new and more interesting way.
